Thank you for your interest in the Balboa Reservoir Project EIR. I am happy to assist.

Regarding your first two questions, I can guide you to the sections of the draft EIR that provide answers. Section 2.E.6 on pages 2-23 describes the 750-space public parking garage, and Appendix B, Initial Study, Section E.14, on pages B-87 through B-90, addresses the secondary effects on City College from the loss of parking at the project site.

Regarding your third question, my role as EIR coordinator is to be neutral and to disclose to the public the environmental impacts of the project without regard to its merits. Thus, I am unable to offer you my opinions about the need for the project or its benefits to City College students. You are welcome to discuss the merits of the project with Sheila Nickolopoulos (cc'd), the community planner assigned to the Balboa Reservoir Project.

Please note that the comment period on the draft EIR ends on September 23<sup>rd</sup>. Also, a public hearing on the draft EIR before the Planning Commission will be held after 1:00 on September 12th. We encourage City College and San Francisco State students as well as all interested parties to provide comment on adequacy of the draft EIR.
