1 The Planning Department is aware that the City College Board of Trustees at its <u>August</u> <u>6July 30</u>, 2020, hearing <u>will be is</u>-considering terms to include in a future memorandum of understanding (MOU) with the project sponsor. <u>AThe</u> draft MOU <u>prepared by City College staff</u> represents <u>City College's</u> internal <u>staff discussionsdialogue</u>. The project sponsor has not agreed to or committed in any way to changes in the draft MOU <u>terms that exceed thebeyond physical</u> <u>improvements what that have has</u> been specifically identified in the FSEIR. Consequently, any such <u>potential</u> improvements <u>that may go beyond those identified in the FSEIR</u> could not have been known at time of <u>the</u> Planning Commission certification of the FSEIR, are considered speculative at this time, and are not addressed further herein.
