### EPA's Final Designations

All areas have been designated as unclassifiable/attainment.

### Areas Designated under the 2010 Air Quality Standards

States submitted recommendations to EPA for nitrogen dioxide (NO<sub>2</sub>) attainment and nonattainment areas in 2011. Some states submitted additional recommendations in 2010 based on more recent or new monitoring data.
