3	Motion directing the Clerk of the Board to prepare findings related to reversing the
4	Planning Commission's certification of the Final Environmental Impact Report

7	WHEREAS, The proposed Balboa Reservoir Project ("Project") proposes
8	redevelopment of the Balboa Reservoir site with mixed-income housing, open space, a
9	childcare facility/community room available for public use, on- and off-street parking, and new
10	streets, utilities, and other infrastructure; and
11	WHEREAS, The Project site is owned by the City and County of San Francisco ("City")
12	under the jurisdiction of the San Francisco Public Utility Commission and is an approximately
13	17.6-acre piece of land, located north of the Ocean Avenue Neighborhood Commercial
14	District, west of the City College of San Francisco Ocean Campus, east of the Westwood Park
15	neighborhood, and south of the Archbishop Riordan High School; and
16	WHEREAS, The City, acting by and through its San Francisco Public Utilities
17	Commission, selected Reservoir Community Partners LLC (a joint venture between BRIDGE
18	Housing Corporation and Avalon Bay Communities), to act as developer and sponsor for the
19	Project; and
20	WHEREAS, The sponsor and City considered two options for the Project's density: 1.)
21	1,100 residential units, and 2.) 1,550 residential units; both with approximately 1.8 million
22	gross square feet of uses at the site, including 1.3 million to 1.5 million gross square feet of
23	residential uses, 10,000 square feet of community space, up to 7,500 gross square feet of
24	retail, 650 residential parking spaces (option 2) to 1,300 parking spaces (550 residential and

750 public spaces in option 1), and building heights from 25 to 78 (option 1) or 25 to 88 fee
(option 2); and

WHEREAS, The Planning Department determined that a Subsequent Environmental Impact Report (hereinafter "SEIR") tiered to the Balboa Park Station Area Plan Environmental Impact Report was required for the proposed Project and provided public notice of that determination by publication in a newspaper of general circulation on October 10, 2018; and

WHEREAS, The Draft SEIR was published on August 7, 2019, and circulated to governmental agencies and to interested organizations and individuals for a 47-day review period that started on August 7, 2019, and ended on September 23, 2019; and

WHEREAS, The Planning Commission held a public hearing on the Draft SEIR on September 12, 2019, and planning commissioners, organizational representatives, and individual members of the public made oral comments at that hearing; and

WHEREAS, The Planning Department prepared a Responses to Comments ("RTC") document, published on April 29, 2020, distributed to the Planning Commission and all parties who commented on the Draft SEIR, and made available to others upon request at the Planning Department offices; and

WHEREAS, The RTC included responses to comments on environmental issues received at the Draft SEIR public hearing that was held on September 12, 2019, and in writing during the 47-day public review period for the Draft SEIR, as well as text changes or revisions that were proposed to the Project, in response to comments received or based on additional information that became available during the public review period and that represent a refinement or clarification to the text of the SEIR; and

WHEREAS, The comments and revisions addressed in the RTC did not identify new significant impacts or a substantial increase in the severity of previously identified impacts, nor did they identify feasible project alternatives or mitigation measures that are considerably

1	different from those analyzed in the Draft SEIR and that the Project sponsor has not agreed to
2	implement, and no significant new information that would require recirculation of the Draft
3	SEIR under section 21092.1 of the California Environmental Quality Act, California Public
4	Resources Code, Sections 21000 et seq. ("CEQA"), and CEQA Guidelines, Section 15088.5,
5	was identified; and
6	WHEREAS, On May 28, 2020, the Planning Commission, by Motion No. 20731,
7	certified a Final Subsequent Environmental Impact Report ("Final SEIR") for the proposed

WHEREAS, On May 28, 2020, the Planning Commission, by Motion No. 20731, certified a Final Subsequent Environmental Impact Report ("Final SEIR") for the proposed Project under CEQA, the CEQA Guidelines, and San Francisco Administrative Code Chapter 31, finding that the Final SEIR reflects the independent judgment and analysis of the City and County of San Francisco, that it is adequate, accurate and objective, and contains no significant revisions to the Draft SEIR; and

WHEREAS, By letter to the Clerk of the Board by Stuart M. Flashman on behalf of appellants Madeline Mueller, Alvin Ja, and Wynd Kaufmyn ("the Appellant"), received by the Clerk's Office on June 18, 2020, the Appellant appealed the Final SEIR certification; and

WHEREAS, The Planning Department's Deputy Environmental Review Officer, by memorandum to the Clerk of the Board dated July 24, 2020, determined that the appeals had been timely filed; and

WHEREAS, On August 11, 2020, this Board held a duly noticed public hearing to consider the appeal of the Final SEIR certification filed by Appellant and, following the public hearing, conditionally reversed the Final SEIR certification, subject to the adoption of written findings in support of such determination; and

WHEREAS, In reviewing the appeal of the Final SEIR certification, this Board reviewed and considered the determination, the appeal letter, the responses to the appeal documents that the Planning Department prepared, the other written records before the Board of Supervisors and all of the public testimony made in support of and opposed to the appeal; and

WHEREAS, Following the conclusion of the public hearing, the Board of Supervisors conditionally reversed the Final SEIR certification, subject to the adoption of written findings of the Board in support of such determination, based on the written record before the Board of Supervisors as well as all of the testimony at the public hearing in support of and opposed to the appeal; and

WHEREAS. The written record and oral testimony in support of and opposed to the appeal and deliberation of the oral and written testimony at the public hearing before the Board of Supervisors by all parties and the public in support of and opposed to the appeal of the Final SEIR certification is in the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors File No. 200804 and is incorporated in this motion as though set forth in its entirety; now, therefore, be it

MOVED, That this Board of Supervisors directs the Clerk of the Board to prepare the findings specifying the basis for its decision on the appeal of the Planning Commission's certification of the Final SEIR for the project.
