- Site grading and street slopes

- Fire truck turning studies
- Street cross sections

10/3/18 Meeting

- Proposed public utilities
 - Low pressure water
 - AWSS
 - Combined sewer
 - SFPUC power equipment and joint trench
- Existing City College utilities in Proposed Lee Avenue R.O.W.
 - 72" storm drain detention pipe
 - 10" sanitary sewer line
 - 8" fire water line
 - Geothermal system

11/7/18 Meeting

- Stormwater management approach and concepts
 - Centralized vs. localized stormwater management approach
 - "Oversize" stormwater management areas to offset public R.O.W.
- Non-Potable Water Ordinance
 - District wide approach not practical due to different ownerships and project phasing
 - Compliance on a per building basis
