The document says there is no mitigation possible. Does that mean there is nothing they can do, but we can do something? Adding 6% ridership to the K's max-load point means more people being passed up at West Portal, Forrest Hill, Castro, Church, and possibly Van Ness inbound in the mornings. That's not something we would like to see.
