The Balboa Reservoir developer has been working with OEWD and Planning to develop a recreational area concept for the 80-foot property at the southern end of the Balboa Reservoir. The SFPUC will continue to own the property but the development team wants to beautify it since it will be the gateway to the development.

My goal is to ensure that CDD has the access it needs on this property to maintain and repair its existing pipelines and eventually add the third Crosstown Pipeline.
