This is to confirm that we will need a 25' wide paved path as shown in blue in Figure 6.4-5 for CDD access to the valves and pipeline for future maintenance. We also require a vehicle turnaround area at the west end of our ROW currently identified as Dog Park. The turnaround area should be designed to accommodate Peterbilt model 320, 3-axle, 10 CY overhead loader with a turning radius of 24 ft. Let me know if you need additional information. Thanks Sam
