Hi-

For the Monday afternoon Balboa Res meeting: the question will be whether there are any Muni forward type treatments that we would want to see/would reduce delay on any of the lines that go on Frida Kahlo or Ocean. The idea is that the project sponsor would pay for some portion as part of their cumulative transit delay impact mitigation.

So, these would be things we would actually want to implement- because we would need to pay for part also. We do not need to commit on Monday, but pls think about this in advance.
