Thank you for your inquiry.

This is what I said at the CAC meeting: City College is in the Plan Area, but because the Community College District is a separate jurisdictional entity from the City and County of San Francisco, the San Francisco Planning Department is not the lead agency that conducts CEQA for their projects. However, we do consider their existing conditions and foreseeable projects in our CEQA analysis.

City College of San Francisco is the governmental agency responsible for CEQA analysis at its own facilities.
